THE PLF SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE ISSUE OF ASSASSINATING THE INVALID U.S. PASSENGER WAS FABRICATED BY THE U.S. INTELLIGENCE ORGANS TO JUSTIFY THE OPERATION AGAINST THE PLANE.

WE ASKED HIM ABOUT THE PRESENCE OF [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ON THE HIJACKED PLANE AS ASSERTED BY THE ISRAELI DEFENSE MINISTER, BUT THE PLF SPOKESMAN DECLINED TO ANSWER.
